

Mayerson JCC – Camp at the J

Camp Location: 8485 Ridge Road Cincinnati, Ohio

Type of Camp: Day camp

Camper Requirements: Can communicate their needs in some way, i.e., a talker, pointing, limited words. Can toilet themselves.

Staffing Ratios: 2:15 per bunk. Advocate options are 1:1 or 2:1

Staff Training Process: Weeklong staff training for advocates to know the needs of the children they work with and generalized training for rest of staff

Discipline Policy: We believe in positive guidance and preventative behaviors and all our staff are trained in it. We do not tolerate violence and hitting will get a child sent home.

Safety / Security: Camp is fenced in on the wooded side, Driveway is not fenced in. Pool is fenced in with lifeguards and access is through the camp office.

Willingness to allow an aide (to be provided by the family or county) to support a specific camper: Would have to go through JCC background checks and other possible processes before we could allow them on campus with the kids.

Camp Layout: Most of camp is a flat field archery is down wooded stairs but is moved to the gym for those unable to walk down them. The rest of camp is indoors with access to elevators and handicap restrooms and changing areas.

Communication Style with Parents: Advocates are willing to communicate in whatever way the parent finds best. We will always have a daily chat at pick up.

Field Trips / Off Site Trips: Field trips are for Quest only (6th grade and up) All field trips were planned to be accessible for those with mobility aids

Dietary / Allergy Needs: We are able to accommodate any allergy needs.
